

Overnight Accommodations Information

SOAR Housing Information

If you made a reservation for overnight housing during the SOAR reservation process, the following information is related to your reservation. You and your guests will stay in Elizabeth Waters Hall, located at 1200 Observatory Drive.

If you are arriving the day BEFORE your SOAR program

Check-in @ Elizabeth Waters Front Desk 2–10 p.m.

If you plan to arrive the day before the start of your SOAR session, you should pick up your room key from the Elizabeth Waters front desk between 2 p.m. and 10 p.m.

- ▶ Short-term parking is available for unloading in front of Elizabeth Waters Hall.
- ▶ As a courtesy to others, there will be no housing check-in after 10 p.m. If, due to extenuating circumstances, you will arrive after 10 p.m., you must contact the Elizabeth Waters Hall desk at 608/262-1800 to make arrangements for your late arrival. You must make arrangements at least one day in advance of your arrival.
- ▶ You will still need to check in to the SOAR program the following day.

If you are arriving the day of your SOAR program

Check-in @ Welcome Center Noon–3:30 p.m.

If you plan to arrive the day of your SOAR session, you should first check in to the SOAR program at the Welcome Center, 21 N. Park Street. After checking into the SOAR program, you should proceed to Elizabeth Waters to pick up your room key between 2 and 3:30 p.m. You will not be able to check into the SOAR program at Elizabeth Waters.

Those who pick up their room keys first will be sent back to the Welcome Center to check in.

Short-term parking is available for unloading in front of Elizabeth Waters Hall.

Check-out

On the day of your departure you will need to check out of your room at the Elizabeth Waters front desk by 8:30 a.m. A secured storage area is available to store your luggage after check-out if needed.

Amenities

Your air-conditioned room is furnished with bed linens, blankets, pillows, bath towels, soap, facial tissues, a small refrigerator, and a telephone. Daily housekeeping service is provided. Local and campus calls are free of charge; long distance calls may be placed using a calling card or by purchasing a prepaid calling card. Please remember to bring a small alarm clock and bathrobe. Shared bathroom facilities with private showers are located on each floor. If you have valuables that you wish to secure, you should bring a small padlock to lock them in a securable drawer, located in each room.

Other Overnight Options

If you have not made a reservation to stay in SOAR housing and plan to stay in Madison during SOAR, we recommend checking UW Conference Centers Lowell Hall, a UW–Extension building, for overnight accommodations.
